## **Rationale**

---

As the only known source of spice, the explosion of Arrakis is extremely detrimental to people across the known universe. Every planet is highly dependent on the production and trade of melange, more commonly known as spice. Spice is a psychedelic drug found in the sands of Arrakis; without it, space travel across the universe is extremely dangerous and inefficient (Dowell). This makes spice an extremely sought-after commodity that brings wealth to those who control it. With the destruction of Arrakis and loss of spice production, Spacing Guild navigators are unable to find safe routes across space; it is expected that every planet will become isolated from each other. There will be widespread panic, famine, and economic suffering. Trade will be far more difficult, leaving some planets to starve. There may be political movements similar to those in the past that will completely change the way human civilization interacts with itself and with its technological advancements. However, some good may come from the loss of Arrakis. It might encourage more cooperation between Houses, and it could lead to a time of prolonged peace.

## **Background of the Issue**

---

The origins of the Fremen are obscured but it is believed that they are descended from Zensunni Wanderers. From about 1380 BG (Before Guild) to 1300 BG, all known Zensunni Wanderers ended their hajra, a holy journey of mind, body, and spirit, when they were transported to Arrakis, settling deep into the desert (Herbert). Before the discovery of spice, Arrakis was a planet of little importance. Only when royal chemist Yanshuph Ashkoko

discovered melange in 1000 BG, along with its life-prolonging effects, did Arrakis gain some importance.

Still, however, Arrakis remained mostly unimportant to wider human affairs. It would remain that way until 108 BG. The Butlerian Jihad, a revolt against all intelligent machines such as computers, conscious robots, and thinking machines, started in 201 BG. During this time, all of these machines were destroyed as a new philosophy took its place: “Man may not be replaced.” (Herbert). This crusade impacted human life socially and politically, reverting human civilizations to something similar to what they were before the many technological advancements, as values were shifted to believe in the divinity and importance of humans. The end of computers in human space, and the beginning of peace among humans in 108 BG, allowed Arrakis to get set on the path to becoming a sought-after prize by the houses of the newly founded Corrino Empire due to the sudden necessity for spice to accomplish long-distance space travel. This, along with the rise in power by the Bene Gesserit in state politics because of their abilities, began the millennia-long rivalry between House Harkonnen and House Atreides that continues to this day.

The invention of foldspace ships in 80 BG, which allowed for faster-than-light travel, and the foundation of the Spacing Guild in 1 AG (After Guild), elevated Arrakis to be the most important planet in the universe, being the only known naturally occurring source of spice. The Spacing Guild was the second mental-physical training school that established the Butlerian Jihad; the organization now has a monopoly over space travel (Herbert).

While Arrakis was originally set to be terraformed and transformed into a paradise, this quickly changed with the discovery and commodification of spice, and it became an economic powerhouse and a political piece for those who controlled it.

## **Current Situation**

---

The year is 10191 AG (After Guild), about 10,000 years after the Butlerian Jihad, and for years now House Harkonnen has been in control of the spice harvesting operations on Arrakis. Recently, Padishah Emperor Shaddam Corrino IV most generously ordered House Atreides to replace House Harkonnen on Arrakis as a reward for their loyalty. However, before Duke Leto Atreides and all his forces can even arrive on Arrakis, the planet spontaneously explodes. Agents of House Atreides, who were already on the planet in preparation for the Duke's arrival, detected unexpected radioactivity and managed to evacuate thousands of inhabitants, the Fremen, before the incident, as well as a small supply of spice that had yet to be exported.

## **Directive**

---

With the explosion of Arrakis, the Fremen people have been displaced and need to find a new place to reside as efficiently as possible. We implore all delegates to explore the importance of finding where Fremen people will live and how their culture will be preserved. Delegates should discuss why and how Arrakis has exploded and will need to discuss the preservation of environmental factors: e.g. spice. With Arrakis being the sole source of spice, delegates will need to search for a new way to source this commodity. Delegates should also keep in mind that keeping secrets will almost always work to their advantage, especially in these circumstances. Here are some questions to consider when beginning your research and preparing for the conference:

1. Why did the planet of Arrakis explode?

2. How will the Fremen's culture be preserved?
3. How should delegates handle the Fremen refugee crisis?
4. How should delegates cope with the loss of spice production?
5. What can delegates do to get spice production back on track?

1. **Amaliyah\*** - She is the advisor and servant to Baron Vladimir Harkonnen. The Baron is extremely secretive and unwilling to share information, but Amaliyah acts as his advisor in his most desperate times. She was born on Geidi Prime and originally worked in the palace as a servant before she began to leave notes for

the Baron that gave him ideas and advice. Aaliyah was promoted and has since been essentially his secretary, managing his meetings.

She is confident and very aggressive when it comes to protecting her loved ones. Since Chani is a Fremen who is deeply tied to the planet's culture, she would be deeply impacted by the loss of Arrakis. After the explosion, Chani would focus on finding all survivors. She would try to adapt to her new environment and seek revenge against whatever caused the explosion, all while preserving her culture.

- 4. Chief Manager of the Spacing Guild\***- They are a manager of the Spacing Guild and a direct representative of the Chief Administrator. They attend meetings in place of and speak on behalf of the Chief Administrator. The Spacing Guild has managed to hold a monopoly on space travel, and without spice, space travel is not safely possible. They must find a way to ensure and secure the position of power held by the Spacing Guild.
